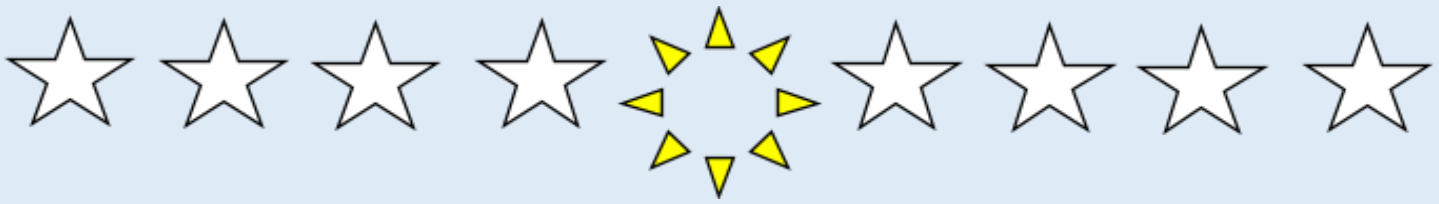

We just missed a big one! Yes, I'm referring to Hurricane Laura that went ashore Thursday morning at the border of Texas and Louisiana as a category 4 storm. Last month's Luff 'n Laff featured resources on preparing for hurricanes that I hope you found useful. Certainly last week I was watching the development of Invest 94 into Tropical Storm Laura and then Hurricane Laura as it exited the west coast of Cuba. That track moved south and west rather early sparing Florida all together except for a brief gust that we noticed on Monday.

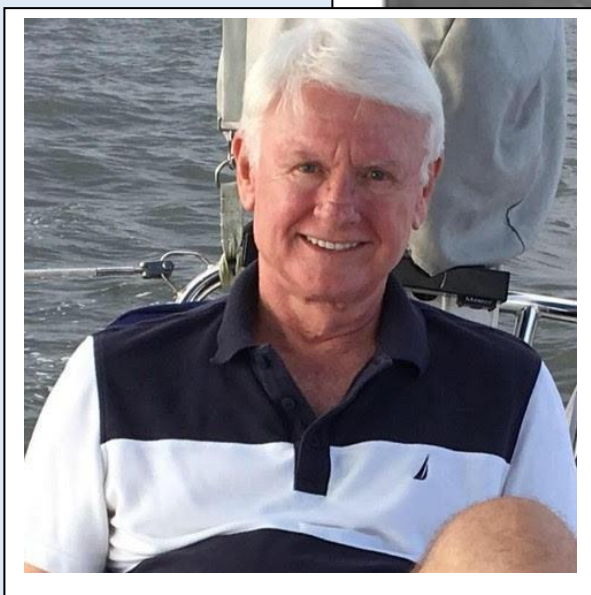
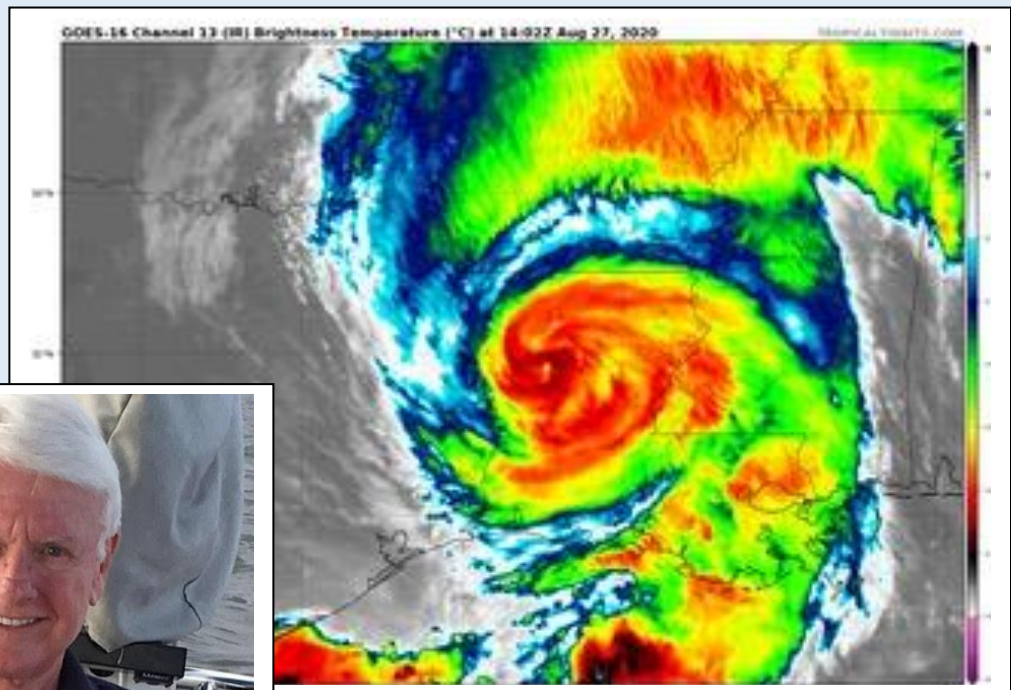
What resources do you find useful for monitoring the tropics other than your local news channels? I would like to share two of mine that I find useful. The first, and perhaps most obvious, is the website for The National Hurricane Center in Miami (www.nhc.noaa.gov). This site provides updates throughout the day with forecast storm track revisions based on several models. The NHC site is very comprehensive, but for having almost anything you can think of for monitoring tropical weather, I recommend "Mike's Weather Page" (www.spaghettimodels.com). Florida-based Mike is careful to state that he is not a meteorologist, but a weather enthusiast, and his extensive information will keep you informed long before local news reports pick up on developing storms. There are also live discussions that I find very informative at 9:19am and also 8 pm.

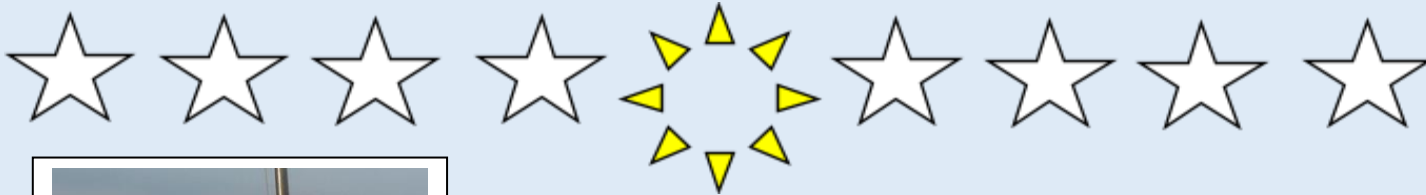
As we enter September, we are at our peak hurricane season, so keep informed and prepared!

I wanted to bring to your attention two special events.

1) SAMI is planning a “Sail To” event on Saturday, September 12th at Smokehouse Bay, Marco Island. All GCSC members are invited. Each boat will arrive at Smokehouse Bay and anchor 50 feet from all other boats (Covid 19 requirement). Dinghy transportation will not be available for land based members. Those boats with dinghies can visit other boats but not board maintaining at least a 6 ft distance. No food or drink can be shared (for more details see the announcement later in this newsletter).

2) GCSC Marathon Cruise March 12-15: The Marathon Cruise is a great stop over opportunity for those of you heading to the Bahamas, Key West, Dry Tortugas, or other fun destinations. If you want a slip at the Marlin Bay Resort + Marina you need to reserve your slip NOW as the marina is filling up fast for that Seafood Festival weekend. Marlin Marina has given GCSC members a 10% discount for reservations made in the next 10 days so mention that you are a member of GCSC. 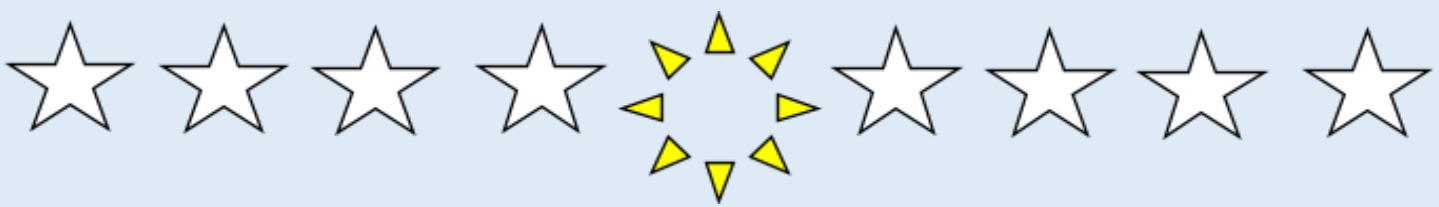
*It is about 10 NM from Gordon Pass.

All boats will use VHF # 72 for communication.

Covid-19 rules for boating in Florida that may affect our Sept. 12 Smokehouse Bay event (if the rules do not relax):

- Marinas, boat launches, docking, fueling marine supply and marina services are open statewide.
- All recreational boats must be at least 50 feet apart. Each recreational vessel must not have more than 10 people on board.
- Boats must remain 50-feet apart when anchored and rafting up is not permitted.
- Boats that are 25 feet or less can only have four adults; boats 25 to 36 feet may accommodate six adults; while boats 37 feet or larger can have up to eight adults and two children on board.

Long Course

The race will start at 10A.m. on Sunday morning, August 30. The race will be a pursuit start. In this format, boats receive staggered start times based on their PHRF ratings, i.e. the slower boats start first, followed by faster and faster boats, with the scratch boat starting last. This eliminates all those crowds at the start. It also makes crystal clear how you're doing against the competition: the first boat to the finish wins, simple as that.

Please find the attached current scratch sheet for the course. The list is created with as many boats as have been racing, so that if you decide to race your start time is already decided, based on your rating. Please race with people in your household or if not from the same household people in your trust group!

The start and finish will be an imaginary line due west of Gordon Pass marker #1, starting in a northern direction. You will sail 5.7 miles to Doctors Pass, around the Doctors Pass Marker "DP". You will then proceed to a yellow inflatable mark 2 miles West of the Naples pier, then sail to the finish at Gordon Pass.

The race distance is 12.4 Miles and communications will be on VHF channel 72.

Short Course

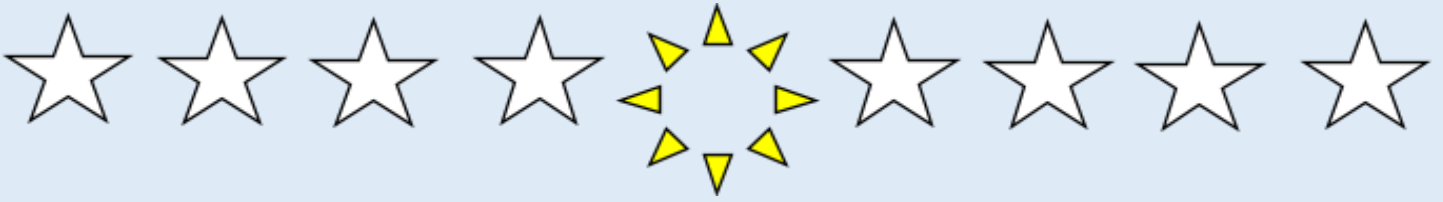
The start and finish will be an imaginary line due west of Gordon Pass marker #1, starting in a northern direction. You will sail 2.8 miles to a line about 200 yards straight off the Naples Pier. You will then proceed to a yellow inflatable mark 2 miles West of the Naples pier, then sail 3.5 miles to the finish at Gordon Pass.

The race distance is 8.3 Miles

Special thanks to Jerry Watkins who will be calling out instructions and to Dennis and Jennifer and the crew of No Name who will be setting the mark.

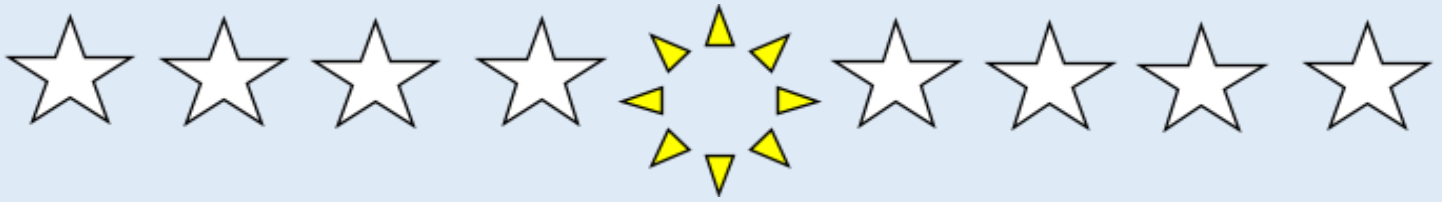

NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules

1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 class rules of WFPHRF, and by the Sailing Instructions.

2. Eligibility

2.1 Open to any self-righting, enclosed cabin sailboat and multi-hull that conform to class rules and holds a valid WFPHRF certificate.

3. Entries and Fees

3.1 The Entry fee for this event is \$70.00 or \$63.00 for PHRF racers providing proof of current US Sailing membership. Lou Tilley Race fee is \$50.00.

3.3 Entries must be made on the official entry form accompanied by a check for the entry fee made payable to CMCS. All entries must be current with their WFPHRF. WFPHRF certificates are not required, but encouraged, for the Cruising entries for the Lou Tilley Race.

3.4 Entry deadline is 1700 hrs., Tuesday, September 29th, 2020.

4. Divisions

4.1 Divisions will be PHRF Spinnaker, PHRF Non-spinnaker, One Design (3 or more entries), PHRF True Cruising, and PHRF Multi Hull. The Race Committee may combine or divide Divisions based upon the number of entries. A boat will not be placed in a Division other than the one of the skipper's choosing without consultation with that skipper.

4.2 A Special Cruising Division has been established for Sunday's Lou Tilley race which will be shorter than PHRF fleet race.

5. Starts & Racing Area

5.1 The races on Saturday, October 3rd will be buoy races in the vicinity of the San Carlos Light. The first warning signal for the first race will be at 0955 hrs. The warning signal for succeeding races will follow the last boat in your class to finish, but at no predetermined interval. There will be no starts after 1500 hrs.

5.2 The Race Committee has planned a distance race for Sunday, October 4th starting near San Carlos Light (SC) and finishing off The Pier @ Ft Myers Beach. The first warning signal will be at 0955 hrs.

5.3 The Race Committee has also planned a Lou Tilley race for Sunday, October 4th starting in the vicinity of San Carlos Light (SC) and finishing off vicinity of the Pier @ Fort Myers Beach. This race course (shorter) will differ from the race course used for the racing divisions and be open only to those entered as Cruisers. The first warning signal will be at 0925 hrs.

5.4 GPS coordinates for some or all of the marks to be used in the Sunday race will be published in the Sailing Instructions. Yachts are encouraged to have a GPS.

6. Sailing Instructions

6.1 Sailing Instructions will be available at the Skippers Packet Pick Up and on the SummerSet Regatta website www.SummerSetRegatta.com prior to Saturday's racing.

7. Scoring

7.1 Corrected times will be calculated based upon boat's finishing time and handicap used. The low point scoring system will be used and there will be no throw-outs. Time on Distance scoring will be used. The low point Scoring System will be used according to Appendix A 4.1 of the Racing Rules of Sailing to determine Regatta winners. One race constitutes a regatta; no races will be excluded.

7.2 Trophies will be awarded in each Division for the Sunday race and in each Division combining all Saturday and Sunday races.

7.3 Awards will be presented for the Sunday Cruisers Race.

8. Communication

8.1 All boats shall carry a working VHF radio capable of sending and receiving on marine channel 72 and weather channels. A boat retiring shall notify the signals boat as soon as possible.

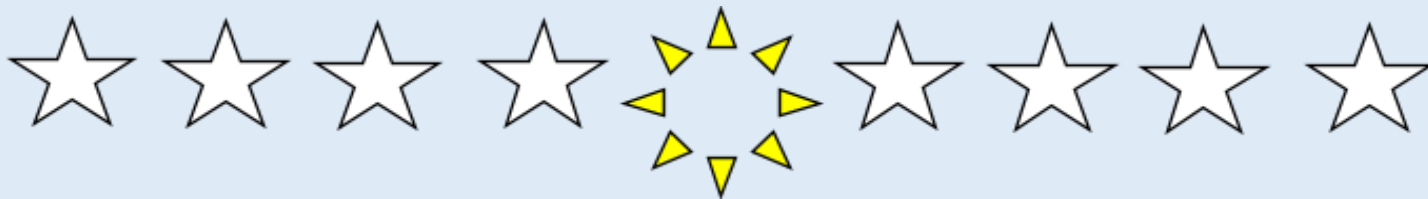

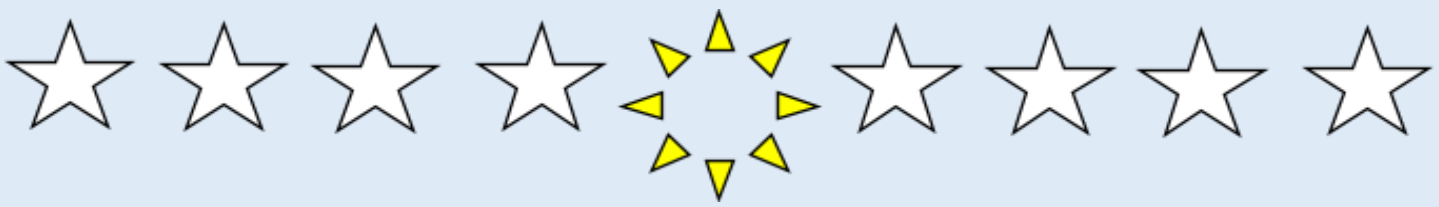
